Beesly's intentions regarding text underlay in verses 2-4 is unclear; the repetition of the text of verse 1 in subsequent verses in bars 1-7 is an editorial suggestion for performance.

Bar 4 bass has \circ with no following rest in original.

Bar 5 tenor note 3: Knapp has g'.

Bar 6 bass note 2: Knapp has c'.

Bar 10 alto note 4: both sources have b'; perhaps terzverschiebung error.
