## Editorial notes and emendation:

This edition is based on a transcription by Ros Clements from Aaron Williams' Royal Harmony (London c.1765). Williams ascribes the anthem to "Clark and Green". The general style is consistent with that of James Green (fl. 1713-51) and his brother John (fl. 1713). Another of James's anthems appears in the collection. The Clark referred to is unlikely to be Jeremiah Clark(e) (1674-1707), nor his cousin Thomas (fl. 1705) whose anthem styles were more conventional. The text is from Matthew chapter 21 verse 5 and Luke chapter 19 verses 37-38.

Bar 1: No indication as to which voice sings the upper line; tenor is most likely on general stylistic grounds.  
Bar 17 alto note 2: f#'
